

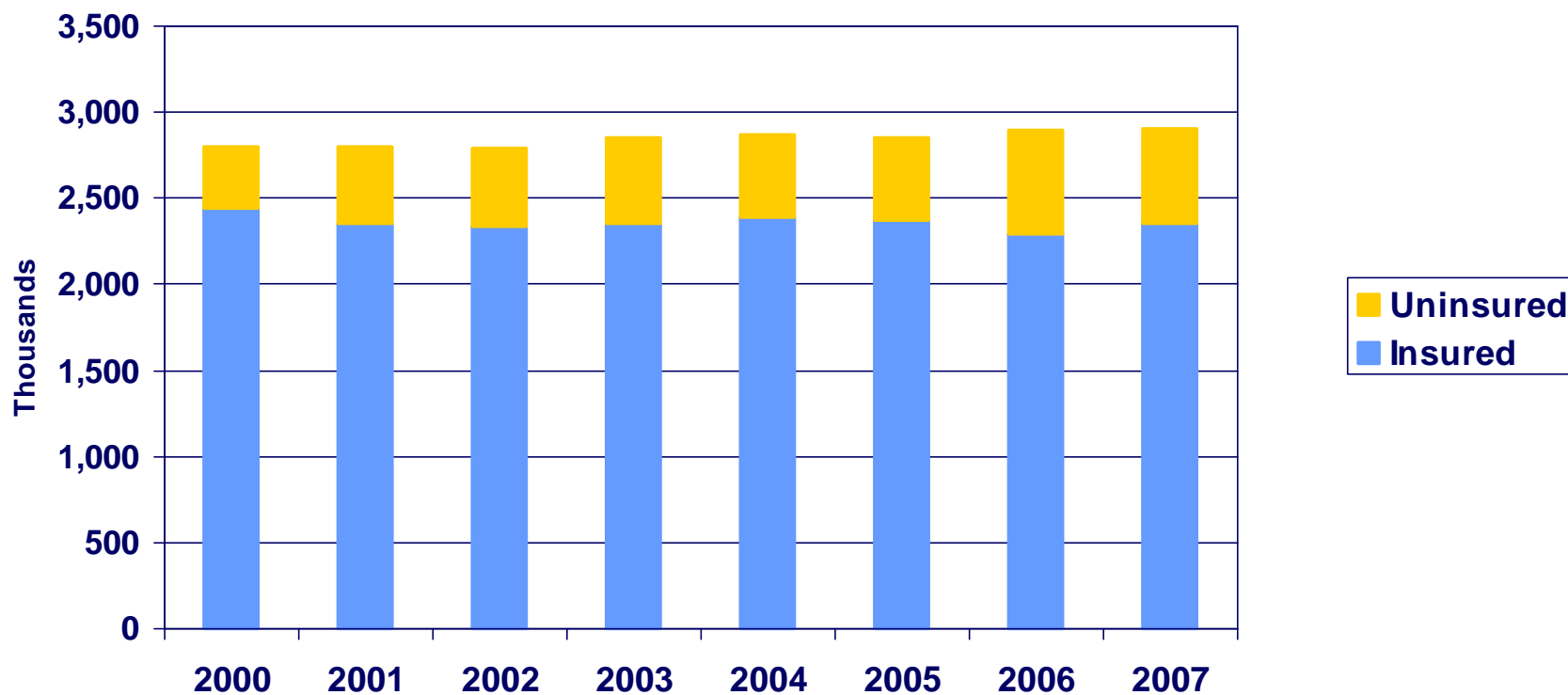

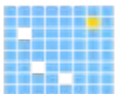

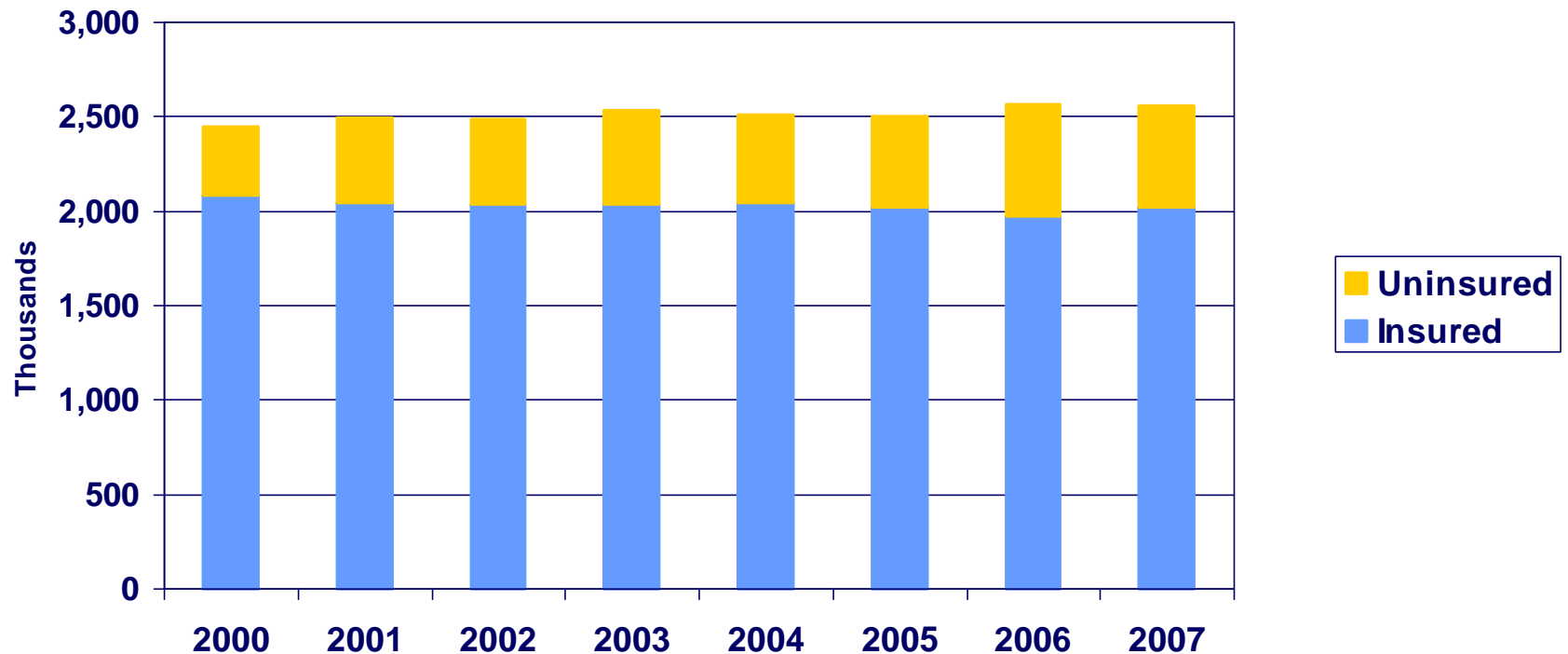
Insurance Status of All Persons in Mississippi, 2000 - 2007

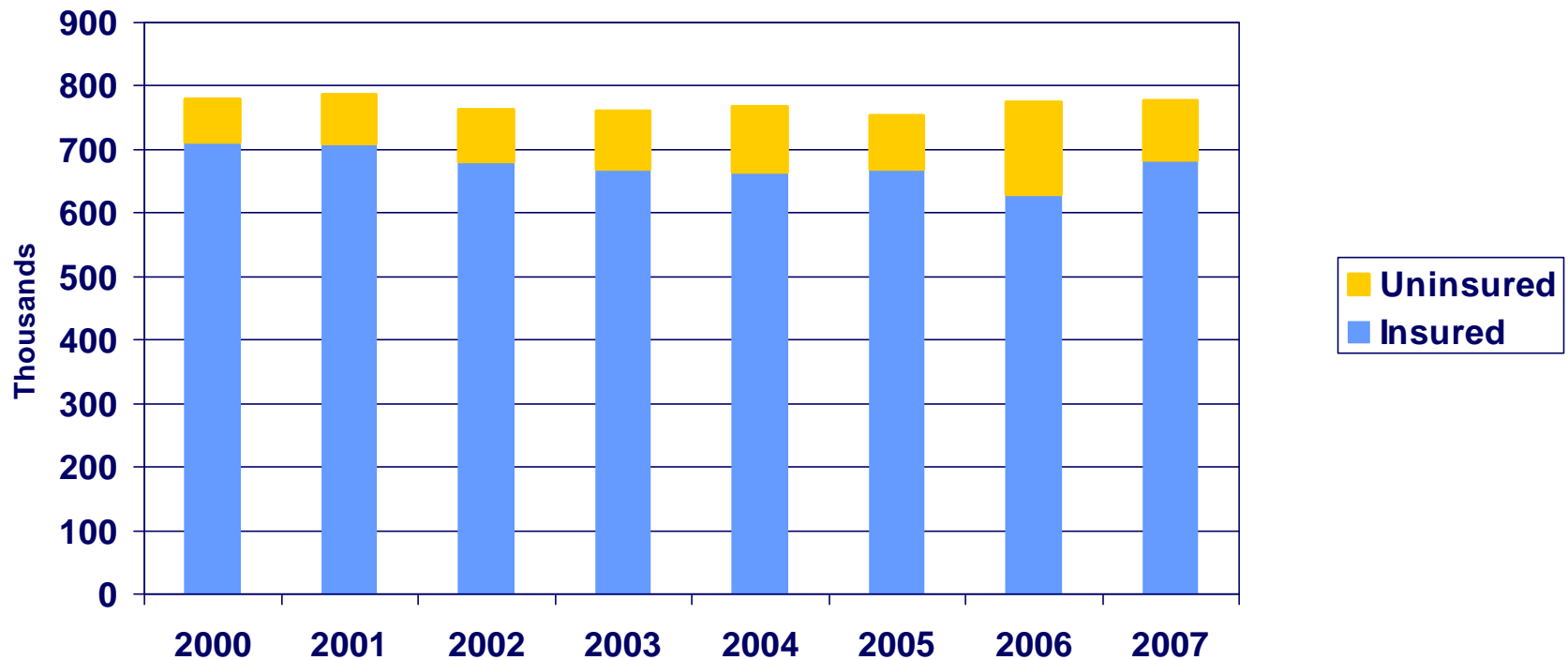


Insurance Status of Persons < 65 in Mississippi, 2000 - 2007



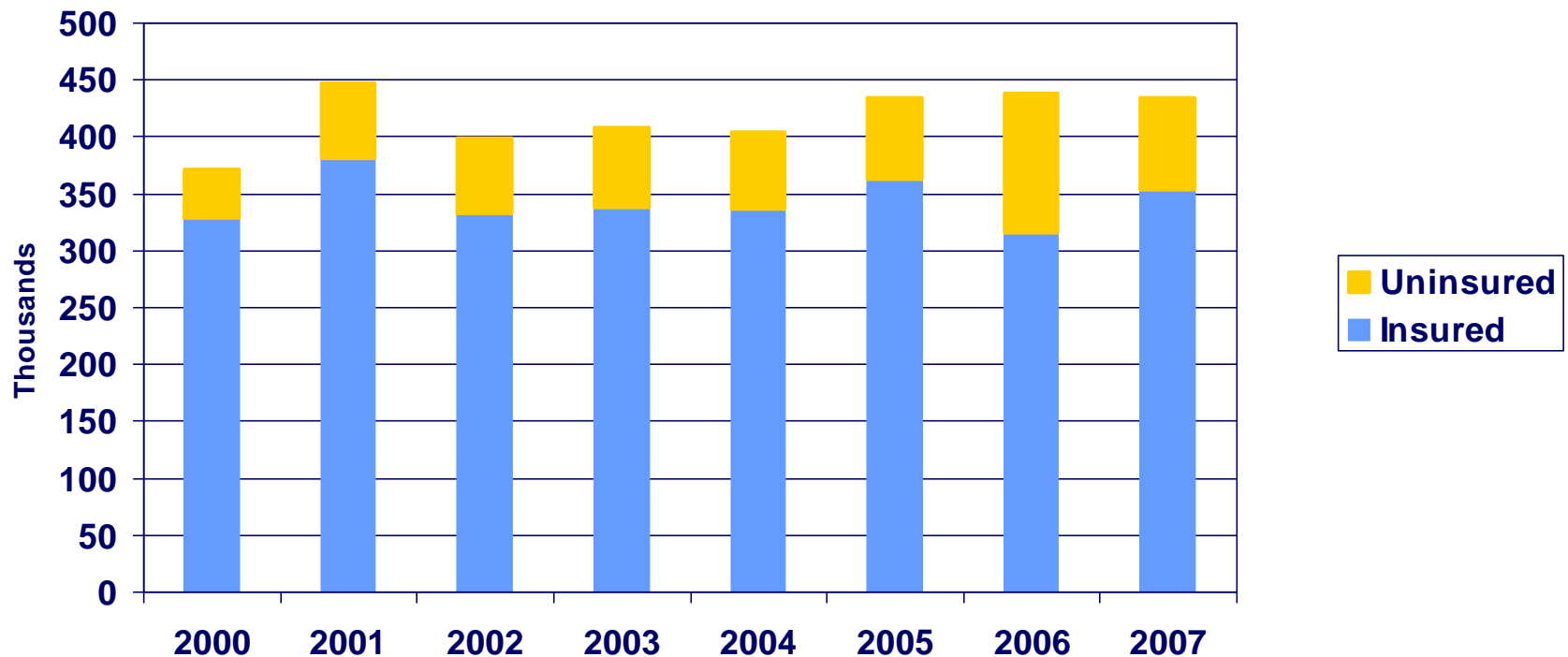

Insurance Status of Persons < 18 in Mississippi, 2000 - 2007



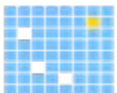

Insurance Status of Low-Income Children in Mississippi, 2000 - 2007

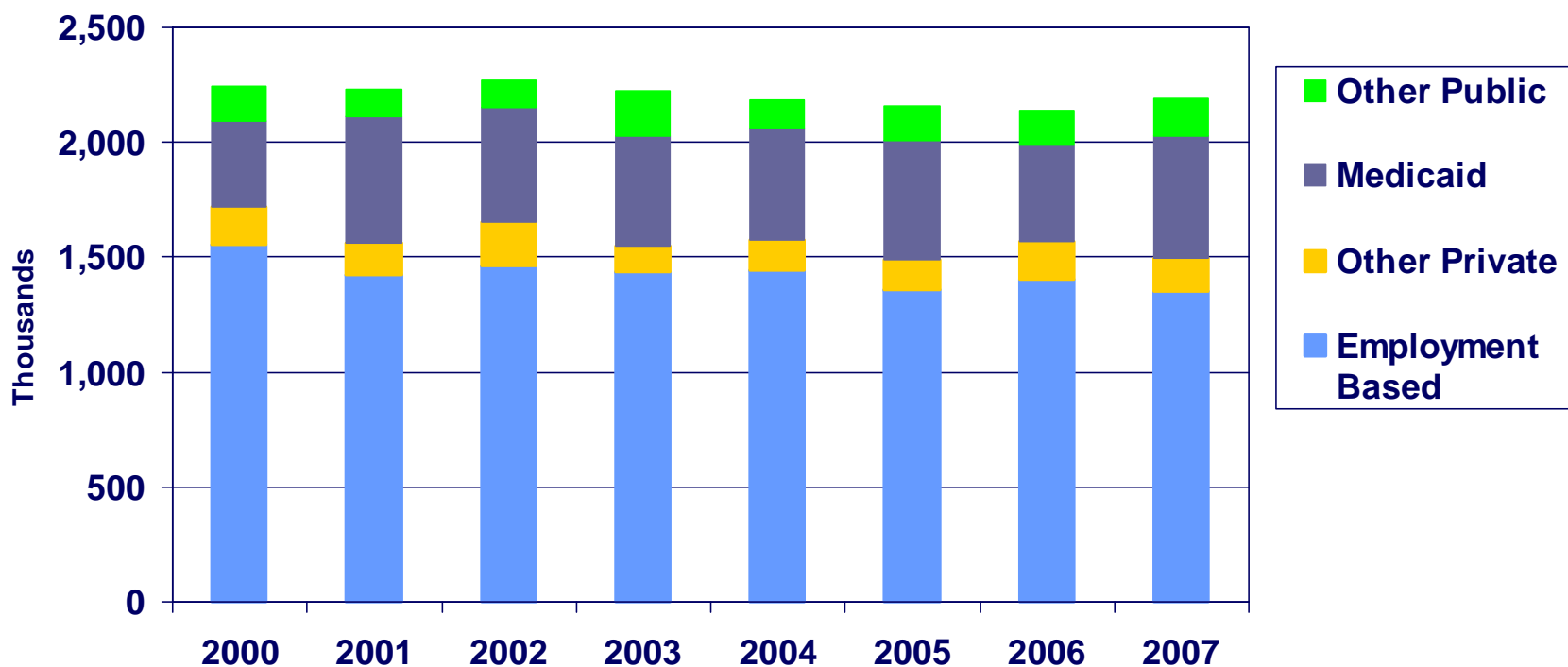

Note: Low-income children include persons under 19 years of age in households with incomes at or below 200% of the federal poverty level.



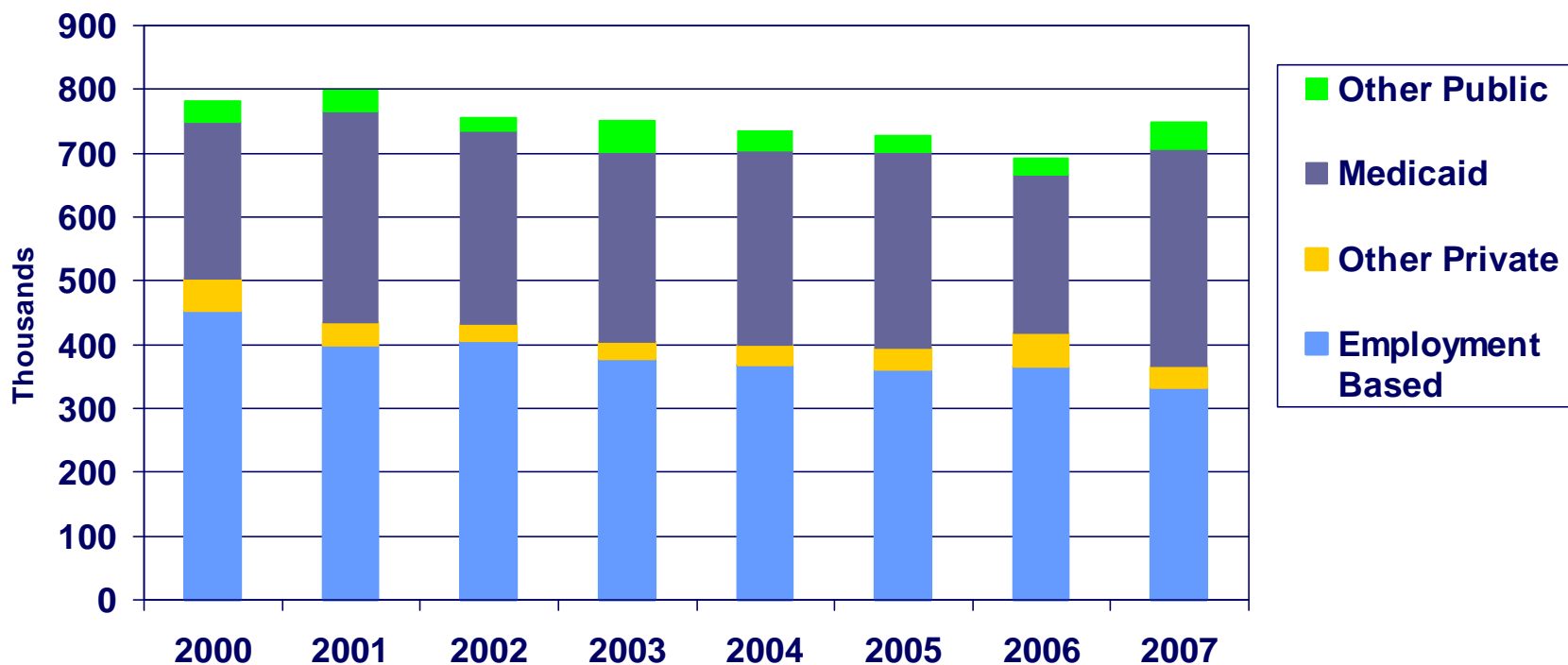
Insurance Coverage by Type for Persons < 65 in Mississippi, 2000 - 2007
